

What is Data about SDOH & Place?

The Social Determinants of Health (SDOH) are the conditions in which people are born, live, learn, work, play, worship, & age that affect a range of health outcomes.

Place-based data about SDOH is often geospatial in nature, linking crucial information about the neighborhoods and regions in which people reside.

Ensuring all have easy access to harmonized, Place-Based SDOH data in which they live, work, advocate for, and/or research is crucial for health equity.

The Challenge

Place-based SDOH data can be difficult to find and difficult to use. It is often split across multiple, siloed, programs and systems that often take years to master, from city data outlets to the

Our goal is to make it easier to access and work with SDOH and place data, breaking down existing silos to further health equity.


